Our Learning Goals

"Je peux..." (I can...) In our French class, we are working together, aiming to empower our students with valuable language skills. These are the "Je peux" statements, representing what your child will achieve this term:

Intermédiaire (Intermediate):

1. Je peux identifier et partager du vocabulaire familial en français. (I can identify and share family vocabulary in French.)
2. Je peux identifier les formes masculines et féminines des mots. (I can identify masculine and feminine forms of words.)
3. Je peux conjuguer le verbe "être". (I can conjugate the verb "être".)
4. Je peux identifier les traditions du carnaval et mes propres traditions. (I can identify the traditions of carnival and my own traditions.)
5. Je peux continuer à pratiquer le vocabulaire courant de la classe. (I can continue to practice common classroom vocabulary.)
6. Je peux identifier et partager quelques animaux et leurs caractéristiques en français. (I can identify and share some animals and their traits.)

Primaire (Primary):

1. Je peux chanter des chansons en français. (I can sing songs in French.)
2. Je peux compter jusqu'à trente en français. (I can count to thirty in French.)
3. Je peux identifier et partager les jours de la semaine en français. (I can identify and share the days of the week in French.)
4. Je peux chanter l'alphabet en français. (I can sing the alphabet in French.)
5. Je peux identifier quelques termes liés à la météo en français. (I can identify some weather-related terms in French.)
6. Je peux identifier et partager les couleurs en français. (I can identify and share colors in French.)
