CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

- <u>Agenda</u> It is mandatory that students bring their agenda home every day for parents to review and sign. Parents/guardians may also use it to communicate with the teacher.
- <u>Homework</u> Spelling words will be sent home on Monday and tests will be on Friday. Some class time is given for practice, but students are encouraged to study nightly as needed. Any other work not completed during class time will be assigned for homework.
- <u>Toys/Phones</u> Any items not required for learning are a distraction and are to be kept at home.
- Class Norms Our class norms are the expectations for everyone in our class.
 - Being responsible and helpful
 - Being calm, quiet, and kind
 - Keeping the class clean and respectable
 - Everyone is safe and learning
 - Including everyone
 - Having Fun
- <u>Classroom Management</u> Students are given reminders during the day about classroom expectations such as listening, working, and staying in their seats. Students struggling to meet these and other classroom expectations will be spoken to in private first. If their choices continue to be a disruption to their learning or to others, students will be required to complete a reflection sheet that will help them analyze the choices they are making in class. The reflection sheet will be sent home for their parent/guardian to review and discuss with them. The next step will be a phone call home to discuss the issue and plan for mitigation. If all of the steps above fail to help the student meet expectations, then the Principal will be asked to intervene.

LEARNING UPDATE

- ~ Math While the students continue to practice number sense, multiplication, and division strategies, we will be introducing fractions and then decimals..
- ~ Language Arts We are continuing to practice grammar and punctuation as we work up to building paragraphs. The Daily 5 is one way that we are structuring our time to give students opportunities to read, write, and develop literacy skills. The Daily 5 offers students choice, structure, teamwork, and small group instruction with the teacher. Students will continue to study spelling words each week.
- ~ Science/ADST: We are going to be busy exploring machines this term. Students will learn about force and energy. It is a hands-on and engaging unit always a popular favorite!
- ~ **Social Studies**: Later, we will be studying Canadian citizenship and government such as levels of government, the election process and how governments make decisions.
- ~ Career Ed. Students are continuing to develop leadership and teamwork skills while doing comprehensive classroom jobs. In their teams, students use problemsolving and decision-making skills as well as contribute to the classroom in a meaningful and purposeful way.
- ~ **Arts Ed.-** Through skits and story theatre, students will develop creative expression by studying characters, movement skills, mood, and plot.
