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Important Dates:

Please see the school calendar for important dates. I will send out a reminder on SpacesEDU when important events are happening.

Materials and Supplies:

Students of Notre Dame do not need to bring any supplies except indoor running shoes. I usually ask for parents to bring in a box of Kleenex and some Lysol wipes for any clean up that occurs during the day. Please keep all special items or classroom supplies from home, at home. If your child needs to bring something special for comfort, it will need to stay in their backpack.

Allergy Aware:

We are an allergy-aware classroom. This means that we have students who cannot eat nuts, cow's milk, and gluten. Please remind your child not to share food with anyone in the classroom. In the past, families have brought in special treats for special occasions. For these events, please remember to bring treats that everyone can enjoy.

Students are reminded that snacks and lunch are to be eaten in the classroom. For safety reasons, such as allergies, we cannot eat recess snacks or lunch on the playground.

Some best practices we do in the school setting to be allergen-aware are:

- Students wash their hands before and after lunch.
- Allergy Alert Signs are at all classroom door entrances.
- Students are not to share food.
- Our custodian washes desks down twice throughout the day.
- If a child brings an allergen in their lunch or snack, that child will be moved to eat in an area not generally used by the general student population to have their snack/lunch.
- Notre Dame school staff and our family community are aware of allergies through school and classroom newsletters and SPACES EDU.

SpacesEDU:

This year, we will be using SpacesEDU as our main form of communication with parents. Through SpacesEDU, we will announce special events, share awards, prayer intentions, and updates about our learning. Our goal is to spark meaningful conversations at home about what we are doing in school.

Please make sure you have accepted the invite to SpacesEDU. If you have not received one, reach out to me so I can verify the email I have on file. As a reminder, photos shared on SpacesEDU should not be posted on social media. I truly appreciate your cooperation. If you have any questions about using SpacesEDU, feel free to contact me.

Our Learning Intentions:

Reading:

- I can use illustrations and prior knowledge to make predictions about what I am reading.
- I can share my ideas about what I am reading.
- I can retell what has happened in a story.
- I can make a personal connection to what I am reading.

Writing:

- I can use proper letter formation in my writing.
 - * small letters small, tall letters tall and fall letters fall
- I can use proper spacing in my writing.
 - * meatball and spaghetti
- I can start my sentence with a capital letter and end my sentence with a period.

Oral Language:

- I can share my ideas with others.
- I can be a respectful audience member.
- I can ask questions that are related to the topic.
- I can make personal connections to others.

Math:

- I can arrange, recognize, compare, and order numbers to 20.
- I can subitize numbers within 10.
- I can skip count by 2 and 5.
- I can count on and count back within 20.
- I can relate numbers to benchmarks from 5, 10, and 20.

Science:

- I can observe patterns and cycles that occur in the night sky.
- I can observe patterns and cycles that occur in our local landscape.

Social Studies:

- I can identify my rights.
- I can identify my role in the classroom, at home, and in the community.
- I can identify my responsibilities in the classroom, at home, and in the community.
- I can identify how my rights, roles, and responsibilities are important for building strong communities.

Christian Education:

- I can pray alone, and with others.
- I can participate in Mass.
- I can tell about the Story of Creation.
- I can show respect for Creation.
- I can listen to bible stories and reflect on the lessons.
- I can pray the Sign of the Cross.

Class Rules and Expectations:

In class, we read several books to help us brainstorm the kind of classroom we want this year. Together, we created five promise statements to guide our behavior and ensure a successful school year for everyone. These promises will help us follow the Notre Dame Code of Conduct.
