## **School Bus Evacuation Safety Policy**

This School Bus Evacuation Safety Procedure is tailored to Notre Dame School and modelled after the SD 59 layout. This version is based on services provided by SD 59 Transportation and other contracted bus providers.

Notre Dame School Bus Evacuation Safety Procedure in Partnership with SD 59 and Contracted Transportation Providers:

#### **Purpose:**

To ensure the safety of all students and staff while being transported to and from school, during field trips, or other off-site activities. This procedure outlines expectations and actions in the event that an emergency evacuation of a school bus is required.

## Scope:

This applies to all Notre Dame School students and staff who ride SD 59 or other contracted school bus services for regular transportation or extracurricular events.

## **Responsibility:**

- **Bus Drivers** (SD 59 and other contractors): Responsible for executing evacuation protocols, maintaining order, and reporting incidents.
- **Notre Dame School Staff**: Responsible for student supervision, pre-trip safety instruction, and post-incident follow-up.
- **Students**: Expected to follow all safety instructions during drills or evacuations.

## **Types of Evacuations:**

Bus evacuations may occur in response to:

- Fire or smoke
- Unsafe road conditions (e.g., rollover risk, blocked roads)
- Mechanical failure
- Collision
- Driver incapacitation

• Flooding or other environmental hazards

#### **Evacuation Drills:**

- Notre Dame School will coordinate with SD 59 and contracted bus services to ensure at least one bus evacuation drill is completed each school year.
- Notre Dame staff will show, review and discuss the bus evacuation video shared by SD 59 with all students at the beginning of each school year.
- Drills will include practice using front, rear, or side exits depending on the situation.
- Students will be instructed on safe exiting procedures and assembly locations after evacuation.
- Staff will assist and debrief students after each drill.

#### **Evacuation Procedures (Driver-led):**

- 1. Stop the Bus safely and activate hazard lights.
- 2. Assess the situation (fire, accident, hazard, etc.).
- 3. Call for emergency help if needed (radio/base contact, 911 if immediate).
- 4. **Give clear instructions** to students for evacuation:
  - Front exit
  - o Rear exit
  - Split evacuation (both exits)
  - o Side door or emergency windows if applicable
- 5. **Direct students** to a safe location away from the road or danger (100 feet or more if possible).
- 6. Take attendance using the student manifest.
- 7. **Remain with students** until help arrives or school staff arrives to assist.

## **Roles of School Staff (Field Trips or Supervision):**

- Ensure all students are accounted for on/off the bus.
- Know where emergency exits and safety equipment (first aid, fire extinguisher) are.
- Assist in maintaining a calm and orderly evacuation.
- Support students with diverse abilities or younger students during exit.

## **Communication and Reporting:**

- All incidents requiring evacuation must be reported immediately to Notre Dame School administration and to the SD 59 Transportation Department or the contracted provider's supervisor.
- An **incident report** will be completed and reviewed.
- Parents will be contacted by school administration if an actual evacuation occurs.

## **Student Expectations:**

- Remain seated and listen to the driver's instructions at all times.
- Learn evacuation routes during drills.
- Practice respectful and calm behaviour during drills and emergencies.

## **Review and Updates:**

This procedure will be reviewed annually and updated in coordination with SD 59 Transportation and other contracted providers to reflect any operational or safety changes.
